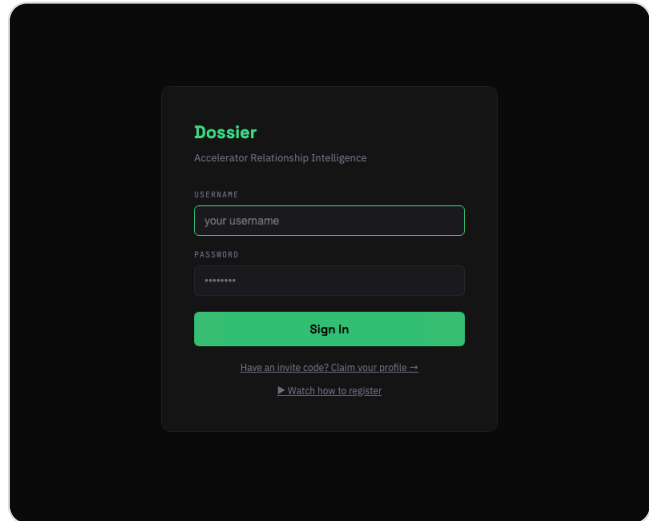


How to Register with an Invite Code

Dossier — Accelerator Relationship Intelligence

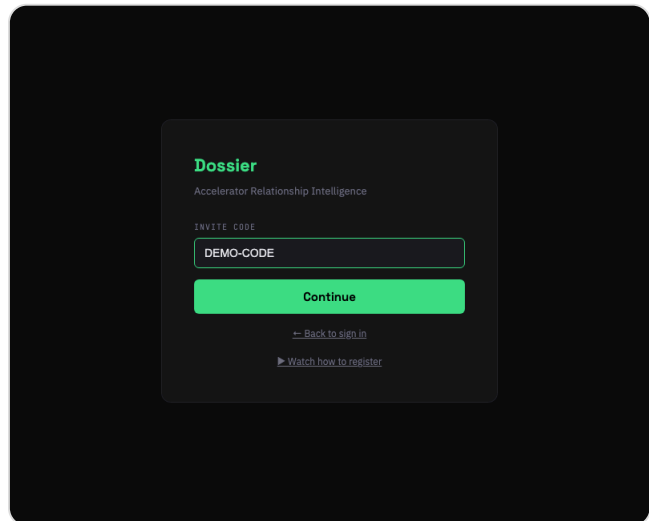
Step 1 — Go to the login page

Open ihub.orlabs.tech. Under the sign-in form, click "Have an invite code? Claim your profile →"

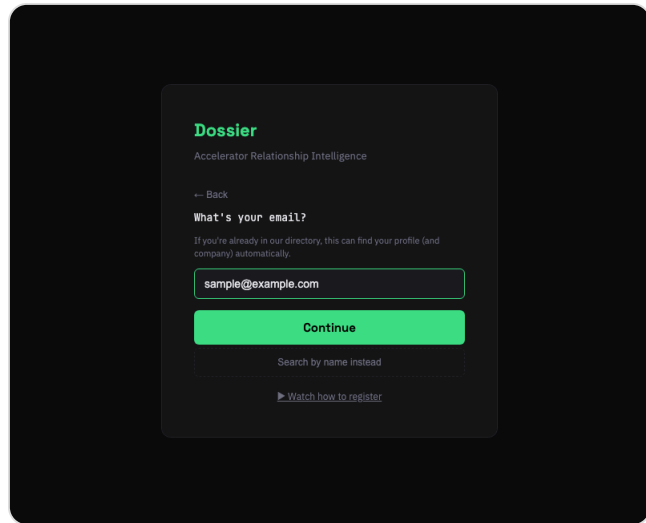
Step 2 — Enter your invite code

Ask iHub staff for the code for your role (founder, mentor, or iHub team). Type it in and click Continue — the code itself determines your role.

Step 3 — Enter your email

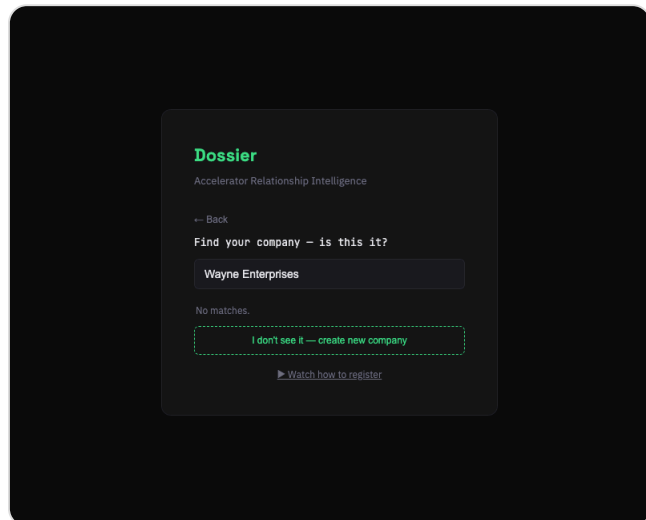
If you're already in our directory (most people are), this finds your profile — and for founders, your company — automatically. Don't have one on file, or prefer not to? Click "Search by name instead."

Step 4 — Confirm your match

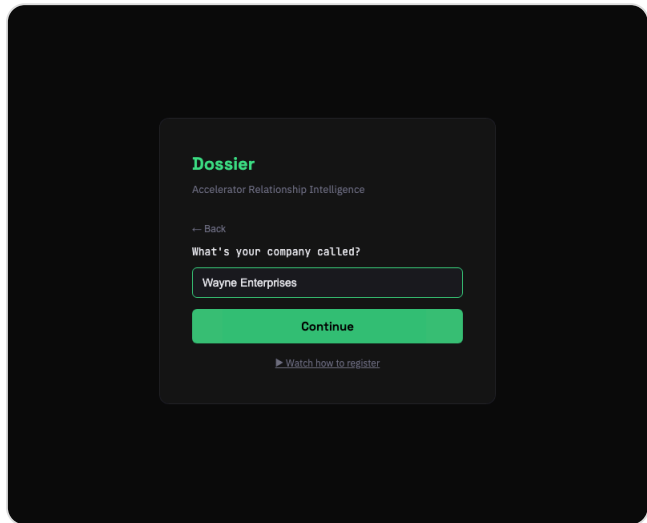
Found a match: founders land straight here, with the company search already run and pre-filled from your profile.

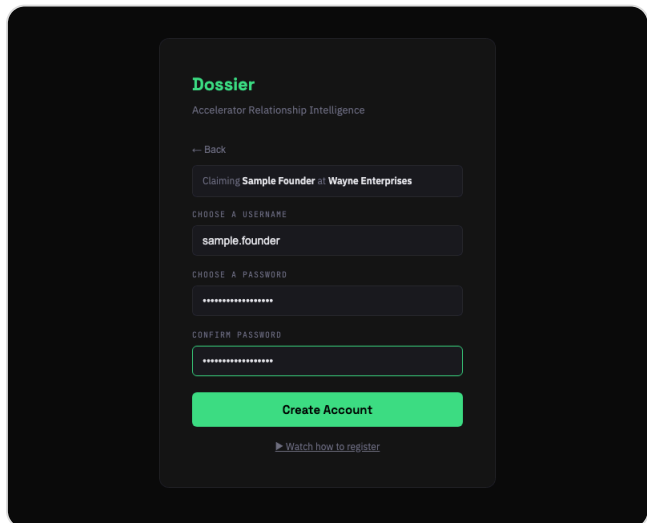

Step 6 — Choose a username and password
